FINAL AGENCY ORDER

Brian H. Jenkins, D.D.S. ("Dr. Jenkins") has submitted an application to the Kansas Dental Board (the "Board") to lift the suspension of his Kansas license to practice dentistry. On August 23, 2007, the Board's Investigation Member issued a Summary Order of Denial. Dr. Jenkins timely requested a hearing. The Board conducted a hearing on September 21, 2007. After considering the application and the evidence admitted at the hearing, the Board enters the following agency order.

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On December 3, 2002, Dr. Jenkins signed a Stipulation agreeing to the Board entering an order indefinitely suspending his Kansas license to practice dentistry, license number 7100. On January 18, 2003, the Board approved the Stipulation and the Board's President signed a Final Agency Order, which adopted the terms of the Stipulation. A true and correct copy of the Stipulation and Final Agency Order is attached hereto.

2. Miguel A. Stamati, M.D., a psychiatrist who has treated Jenkins for a number of years, testified that in his professional opinion, Dr. Jenkins could safely return to the practice of dentistry under certain condition.

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3. Dr. Jenkins testified that he was conscious of the wrongful conduct that lead to his license being suspended and that he had sufficiently rehabilitated himself to a point that he would not be a repeat offender.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND FACT

The Board finds that if certain conditions are met, Dr. Jenkins' license to practice dentistry in Kansas should be reinstated on a limited basis.

III. ORDER

Based upon the foregoing, the Board enters the following order:

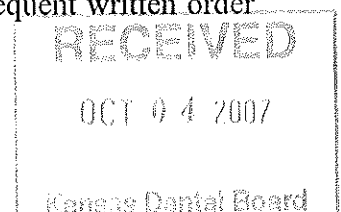
1. Before the indefinite suspension of Dr. Jenkins' Kansas license to practice dentistry is lifted, even in part, Dr. Jenkins must meet the following conditions:

A. Dr. Jenkins must immediately become a participant in the Kansas Dental Impaired Provider Program, enter into a monitoring contract with the Heart of America Professional Network and follow and maintain compliance with all recommendations made to him by those entities until authorized to do otherwise by a subsequent written order of the Board; and

B. Dr. Jenkins must successfully complete a clinical refresher course that has been approved by the Board.

2. If Dr. Jenkins provides evidence, satisfactory to the Board, that he has met the conditions set out in paragraph 1, the suspension of his Kansas license to practice dentistry shall be lifted, but his Kansas license to practice dentistry shall be limited by the following conditions:

A. Dr. Jenkins shall practice dentistry only as part of the GraceMed health clinics of Wichita, Kansas until authorized to practice otherwise by a subsequent written order of the Board;

B. Dr. Jenkins, prior to beginning the practice dentistry as part of GraceMed, and as a condition of his continued practice, shall execute any and all documents necessary to authorize the Board to obtain his Kansas Dental Impaired Provider Program records, his Heart of America Professional Network records, and health and treatment records from all medical and mental health providers who have in the past or in the future provide him care ; and

C. Dr. Jenkins shall arrange for GraceMed to provide the Board quarterly written evaluations of his performance until further order of the Board.

IV. NOTICES

Dr. Jenkins is hereby notified as follows:

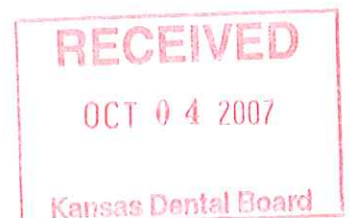
1. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.
2. Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-613, either party may seek judicial review of a final agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
