**NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER  
AND  
PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER**

NOW on this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2009, this matter comes on for consideration by the Presiding Officer to enter a proposed default order.

The Presiding Officer finds:

1. The respondent has failed to participate in the prehearing scheduled for July 21, 2009, and is in default pursuant to Kansas Statutes Annotated (K.S.A.) 77-520.
2. The respondent notified the Presiding Officer and the Kansas Dental Board prior to the prehearing that he would not attend the prehearing.
3. This Proposed Default Order becomes effective 10 days after it was mailed. The respondent has 10 days (7 days plus 3 for mailing) to request this proposed default order be vacated. Such a request must be in writing and be received in the presiding officer's office no later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day after this proposed default order was mailed. The proposed default order will not become effective if the presiding officer vacates it as provided above.
4. If the Proposed Default Order becomes effective, the Summary Order issued on April 2, 2009 will become effective and the Kansas Dental License issued to S. Miegs Jones, Jr., DDS, will be suspended until such time as he complies with the order of the Kansas Dental Board. Pursuant to the Summary Order, the fine imposed is due and owing.

The Presiding Officer, being well and duly advised in the premises, now enters this Proposed Default Order against the respondent. It shall take effect as specified in the above findings.

Appeal Rights and Other Administrative Relief

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-527, either party may request a review of this order by filing a petition for review with the Kansas Dental Board. A petition for review must be filed within 15 days from the date this order becomes effective. Failure to timely request a review by


the Kansas Dental Board may preclude further judicial review. The petition for review shall be mailed or personally delivered to: Betty Wright, Executive Director, Kansas Dental Board, 900 SW Jackson, Room 564-S, Topeka, Kansas 66612.

If neither party requests a review by the Kansas Dental Board, then pursuant to K.S.A. 77-530, this initial order becomes final and binding on both parties on the 30<sup>th</sup> day following its service.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-528, if a stay of the order is desired after a petition for review has been filed, a petition to stay the effectiveness of the order must be filed with the presiding officer prior to the expiration of the time to file a petition for judicial review.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-531, if the initial order is served by mail, three days are added to the time limits set out above.
