**SUMMARY ORDER –Fine \$1000**

**CASE# 07-41**

Dear Dr. Jones:

The Investigative Member of the Kansas Dental Board has reviewed your compliance with the Stipulation and Consent Order dated May 9, 2008. On behalf of the Board you are being fined \$1000.00 for failure to comply with the Consent Order by providing the required continuing education courses as ordered. This additional discipline is based upon the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Licensee signed a Stipulation and Consent Order with the Board on March 13, 2008. The Order became effective on May 9, 2008, and was mailed to the licensee on May 12, 2008.
2. As part of the Order the licensee was ordered and agreed to complete (Paragraph 6.B.) Continuing Dental Education consisting of: Eight (8) hours of dental education on the topic of diagnosis and treatment planning and eight (8) hours of dental education on the topic of periodontal diagnosis and treatment planning within six (6) months of the effective date of the Order, in addition to any continuing education necessary to renew his Kansas dental license'
3. The date the continuing education hours were due was November 15, 2008.
4. The licensee was mailed a letter on December 5, 2008 that the requirement had not been met.
5. To date, no evidence of continuing education has been provided to comply with the order.
6. K.S.A. 77-537 of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act authorizes the use of summary proceedings.
7. The Stipulation and Consent of Order of May 9, 2008 has been violated by the licensee, subjecting his license to further sanctions of the board.

**CONCLUSIONS**

8. Within 10 days of the effective date of this Order, the Licensee shall pay to the Board an administrative fine in the amount of One Thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).

**NOTICES**

9. Failure to provide the continuing education described in Paragraph (2) by June 1, 2008 will result in an additional order being entered suspending the Licensee's Kansas Dental License until such time as the evidence of the required continuing education hours are provided to the board.

10. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537, you may request a hearing on this Summary Order by delivering a written request to:

within fifteen (15) days of the date of service of this order. If a hearing is not requested as described above, the order denying your application for a dental license shall become a final order of the Board, effective upon the expiration of the time to request a hearing. Within fifteen (15) days after entry of a final agency order, either party may file a petition for reconsideration pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529.

Within the time limits established in K.S.A. 77-813, either party may seek judicial review of a Final Agency order, pursuant to said statute. The agency officer designated to receive service of a petition for judicial review is:
